(PUBLIC NOTIFICATION OF NONDISCRIMINATION IN

The Wall Independent School District offers career, technology and vocational programs in agriculture, homemaking, Tech Prep. Admission to these programs is open to all students enrolled in Wall High School, with exception of the Tech Prep programs that are college level courses, which are only available to junior and senior high school students.
