



1st-12th Nomination Window for the Gifted and Talented Program

Parents and guardians may nominate their children for entry into the Wall ISD Gifted and Talented Program. This year's nomination window is February 18-March 1st. If you would like to have your child screened for our G/T program, please request a nomination packet from the front office. The nomination packet will contain a nomination form and a parent survey. Please return the completed forms to the school office no later than March 1, 2019.

A "gifted and talented student" means a child or youth who performs at or shows the potential for performing at a remarkably high level of accomplishment when compared to others of the same age, experience, or environment and who:

- exhibits high performance capability in an intellectual, creative, or artistic area;
- possesses an unusual capacity for leadership; or
- excels in a specific academic field.
